Our initiatives include

- Provide targeted support for students for whom English is an additional language or dialect.
- Invest within the early phase of learning, thereby building a strong foundation for subsequent success.
- Support every student in the development of Reading skills and Comprehension.
- Refining and embedding a researched and connected approach to the teaching of number and writing across the school.
- Supporting staff in differentiation for students and using data to direct student learning.
- Support students with literacy development utilising the Multi-Lit program
- Refine and embed Digital Literacies for all students
- Support the development of STEM

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Implementing the "Read it Again-Foundation Q" program in the Early Phase of Learning- \$ 30,640
- Implementing the Oracy and Literacy program for students who have English as an additional Language or dialect- \$ 15,000
- Support inclusion for all students through teacher aide support in classes \$20,000
- Engaging Literacy & STEM Heads of Curriculum to support teachers in developing high impact pedagogy with a focus on Reading, Writing, Maths, coding and robotics - \$182,000
- Implementing Literacy and Numeracy intervention programs to support identified students \$ 15,000
- Support the development of digital literacies and a STEM approach \$50,000
- Establish the Math Academy to develop excellence in math education \$10,000
- Programs for students identified as working in the Upper two bands through the IMPACT Centre (U2B) \$19,000
