

# Matilda Jnr CSS Musical 2026



Thank you for expressing interest in CSS's Matilda Jnr musical production in 2026! The CSS P&C has been funding and supporting these musicals every second year since 2012: Mary Poppins Jr in 2024; Singin in the Rain Jr in 2022; Hairspray Jr in 2018; Shrek - The Musical in 2016; Disney's Aladdin Jr in 2014; Kids in Paradise in 2012. **The musicals are also important fundraisers for P&C**, so get involved and contribute where and how you can. The musical is a place for children to develop their skills in acting, singing, dancing and stage production to make a story come to life! They will learn how to be part of an inclusive performance program in a team of students, led by parent volunteers and supporting teachers at the school. Engaging in performing arts offers children numerous benefits, including enhanced cognitive skills (memory, critical thinking/problem solving, creativity), improved social interactions, and increased self-confidence. Of course, there is also the pure joy of performing on stage to a supportive audience. This document has been prepared to provide students and parents with a summary of key information in relation to the musical season (starting in Term 1, February, and finishing in mid Term 3, August,) and to communicate our plans & expectations.

#### Overview of 2026

The musical is open to all Year 3 to Year 6 students who want to be involved in the musical as a lead character role, as part of the singing/dancing ensemble or the backstage crew. All roles are equally important and help bring the magic of the musical to the audience. Please note, character roles are for Year 5 and 6 students only – the Year 3 and 4 students will get their turn in years to come! This year the musical auditions will be held early in Term 1 – these are for students wishing to go for character roles only. Those students wanting to be part of the ensemble or backstage crew just need to sign up, get permission and commit to being part of the musical (see student commitment section).

Please note this musical is led and created by parent volunteers in their own time. This is why auditions and rehearsals need to be outside school hours and spread out over a longer time period. This is unlike other schools with teacher-led musicals or plays that have shorter seasons with longer or more frequent weekly rehearsals in school time. As such, please be understanding and respectful of the need to make executive decisions that balance the need of the children in the musical (first and foremost), together with the need to schedule volunteer time amidst family and work life.

#### Schedule

Please refer to the separate schedule document for a detailed plan for the musical season. Please review this carefully to understand if this is something your student and family can commit to. The main days are Thursdays 3-5pm (character roles only) and Sunday afternoons (all cast). Please note: ensemble members and back stage crew are required for Sunday rehearsals only, except for the final stage rehearsal on Ekka Public Holiday on Wednesday 12th August. Auditions for lead roles will start on Sunday 8th February (Week 2 Term 1) and will be held on successive Sundays in Term 1. Ensemble and backstage members will start every Sunday rehearsals in Term 2 with a few welcome and initial song learning rehearsals in Term 1. See below for the key dates.

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#### **Student Commitment**

Please complete & return the 'Commitment & Permission' section at the end of this document and return it to the office by Friday 30/01/2026 (Week 1, Term 1 2026). **If forms are not returned by this date, you will not be able to participate in the musical.** 

It is imperative that students going for lead roles are available for the above-mentioned dates. This is particularly true for the 6 main lead roles – Matilda, Ms Honey, Ms Trunchbull, Mr and Mrs Wormwood and Mrs Phelps the Librarian. Other character roles are expected to be at all the rehearsals they are required for, but will not be required for ALL Thursdays. These dates will be made clear before the

first musical rehearsals start in Term 1. Ensemble students are also expected to attend all Sunday rehearsals—this is made clear in the schedule, so please look at it carefully to understand if this is a commitment your family can prioritize – teamwork makes the dream work! Backstage crew are required every Sunday from 7<sup>th</sup> of June and at all rehearsals and performances. If you have any concern over availability to attend any of the auditions, rehearsals, or performances, please raise this with the producers in the first week of Term 1, 2026, BEFORE signing and returning the commitment contract/permission form. The first introduction will come from a P&C email in Week 1 of Term 1 in 2026. Please reply email any concerns at this time.

#### **Behavioural Standards**

In accepting their place as part of the 2026 musical, students are required to maintain a high level of behavioural standards at all times at auditions, rehearsals & performances – just as they would at school, guided by the SOAR principles of CSS.

Parents are to provide an environment of support, teamwork, encouragement and leadership at all times. Discouraging & unsatisfactory conduct to musical members or volunteer parents will not be tolerated.

Email will be used as a primary means of communication to parents throughout auditions, rehearsals and performances in 2026. It is asked that questions directed to the producers or directors be limited to in person at rehearsals rather than via email in order to respect volunteer personal time.

There will be a dedicated 'Question Time' desk after each rehearsal where students and parents can ask questions of parent volunteers. Questions during rehearsal time will not be answered to maximise focused rehearsal time. Please also avoid asking questions of Ms Eliza at the office during school/work hours.

Mobile communication will be used only in the event that immediate communication needs to be made between production team and parents at rehearsals or performances.
